Projects financed from Norway Grants

"Prevention of Consequences of Diseases and Health Problems in the Paediatric Age, University Hospital Ostrava"

Similarly to other projects, realization of this project began on 14th January 2015, and will be terminated on 30th April 2017. The project is being realized in accordance with the planned schedule, and the activities performed in the course of the project lead to fulfilment of its goals. No financial means were allocated for construction works in the course of this project, nevertheless, the gymnasium premises at the Department of Paediatric Medicine, University Hospital Ostrava have been reconstructed and adjusted from the financial resources of the University Hospital Ostrava; the newly reconstructed premises have been partially refurbished with equipment purchased from the allocated project funds. The outcome of the project will be a new workplace of complex rehabilitation and physiotherapy for paediatric patients at the University Hospital Ostrava.









Apart from this newly built workplace, other, already existing workplaces of the University Hospital Ostrava will be equipped with new technologies financed from the project. Technical specifications of the equipment have been defined and tenders have been launched.

In the course of the "Education" activity, new educational aids and tools for parents and young patients have been prepared. These include 31 information brochures and booklets and 18 DVDs, describing the correct procedures and techniques for diagnostics and solving of problems of the youngest children in the areas of hearing, problems with the neck, eyes, correct breastfeeding and feeding techniques, speech therapy and exercises but also regarding care for new-born babies at risk. These materials are available, especially for parents of paediatric patients, at respective departments of the University Hospital Ostrava.









Integral part of the "Education" activity was the participation of hospital employees upon educational courses organized outside of the FNO premises, but also organising educational events for employees of the hospital and participants from other healthcare establishments.
